Know ye, that reposing special trust and confidence in the Integrity, Diligence and Discretion of _____, Harriner J. Eccles, of Utah, _____ I have nominated, and, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, do appoint him a Member of the Federal Reserve Board for the unexpired portion of the term of ten years from August 10, 1928, _____ and do authorize and empower him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office according to law, and to have and to hold the said Office with all the powers, privileges and emoluments thereunto of right appertaining, unto him the said Harriner J. Eccles, subject to the conditions prescribed by law. _____

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this twenty fifth day of April, _____ in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty five, _____ and of the Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and fifty ninth. _____
