To all who shall see these presents: Greeting.

Know ye, that reposing special trust and confidence in the Integrity, Diligence and Discretion of _____, Marriner S. Eccles, of Utah, I have nominated, and, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, do appoint him a Member of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System for a term of four years from February 1, 1936, _____ and do authorize and empower him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office according to law, and to have and to hold the said Office, with all the powers, privileges and emoluments thereunto of right appertaining, unto him the said Marriner S. Eccles, subject to the conditions prescribed by law. _____

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this thirty first _____ day of January, _____ in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty six, _____ and of the Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and sixtieth. _____
