In re the appointment of Robert T. Stuart, of Oklahoma, as a member of the federal reserve board of governors, the appointment of Mr. Stuart would give general satisfaction to our state and section and district. Missouri now has two federal reserve banks, one at Kansas City and one at St Louis. Texas now has a federal reserve bank, a federal land bank, a regional headquarters of the Home Owners Loan and a regional headquarters of the Resettlement Administration and when Mr. Morrison is confirmed it will have a member of the Board of Governors with the nominee for vice president Texas should be fairly safe.
