Telegram received from Chairman Eccles quote Advise McIntyre do not see at this time how it will be possible for me accept invitation speak before New York Herald Tribune Forum as will be in West until latter part of September My belief meeting would be interpreted as strictly political and if so my appearance may do more harm for Administration than good However if President feels it important for me to appear and meeting is after I return to Washington I will be willing to accept invitation Advise airmail outcome this matter Unquote Will appreciate your reply so can advise Mr. Eccles at early date
