Retel addressed to Marriner Eccles on August twenty-first I wired you at Poughkeepsie as follows quote Telegram received from Chairman Eccles quote Advise McIntyre do not see at this time how it will be possible for me accept invitation speak before New York Herald Tribune Forum as will be in West until latter part of September My belief meeting would be interpreted as strictly political and if so my appearance may do more harm for Administration than good However if President feels it important for me to appear and meeting is after I return to Washington I will be willing to accept invitation Advise airmail outcome this matter Unquote Will appreciate your reply so can advise Mr. Eccles at early date Unquote Mr. Eccles doesn't expect return Washington until about October first At present is on fishing trip somewhere near Yellowstone. In letter received from him yesterday he said unless the President desired him to do so he would not return East in order to make fifteen minute speech before Tribune Forum. He expects attend Dern funeral and you no doubt can get definite reply from him at that time. If desire answer sooner advise me and will try to locate him.
