MEMORANDUM TO ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, COMMISSIONS OR AGENCIES:

The 1941 Red Cross Roll Call will be conducted in the District of Columbia from September twenty-second through October twentieth. To expedite this membership appeal among Federal employees a Government Unit is to be perfected, and with my approval Major General James C. Magee again will serve as the general chairman of this Unit.

More than ever, this year, the Red Cross needs individual support by reason of its increased responsibilities and I sincerely trust that every Federal employee will be extended an opportunity to enroll through the Department, Commission or Agency in which employed. Therefore, you are requested to designate a chairman to organize and supervise the Roll Call in your Department, Commission or Agency.

To ascertain the name of the chairman you appoint, General Magee will contact you at an early date.
