The White House advised me late yesterday afternoon that the President would like the Federal Reserve Board to work up an account of the financial and monetary policies of the Administration. It was suggested that the Board might collaborate with the Treasury, but that the President wished me to give the matter my personal attention. It is desired that there be attached to the account pertinent reports and speeches. The President would like to have this information sometime within the next week. It is to be sent to Mr. Early's attention.

In accordance with our telephone conversation last evening, I would appreciate your giving this matter your early attention, furnishing me with the necessary reports, etc., so that I may see that they get to the White House within a week.

I shall be glad to discuss the matter further with you if you desire.
