My dear Governor:

Attached are copies of letters sent over from the White House. Mr. Ransom will phone you sometime on Monday to discuss this with you. Our own suggestion is that the President write merely a brief acknowledgement to Neighen, ~~thanking~~ thanking him for his helpful suggestion and stating that should occasion arise, he will be very glad to bear it in mind.

As you will note, the letter from DuBois raises highly controversial issues on which it would be very unwise to make a commitment at this time.
