Memorandum for Mr. Jackson

Attached hereto are schedules giving various comparative information and statistics regarding Mellon and independent banks in the city of Pittsburgh and in 17 towns in the Pittsburgh area wherein are located banks controlled by the Mellbank Corporation as well as independent banks.

Some of the significant features as shown by these schedules are set out here as follows:

Number of banks

As of December 31, 1929, in Pittsburgh, there were 72 banks, 8 of which were controlled by Mellon interests as against 64 controlled by other interests.

As of December 31, 1933 the 8 Mellon banks were still open whereas the 64 independent banks had decreased through closings and mergers to 33.

In 1930, one independent bank closed and 7 were merged. Practically all the mergers were into the Peoples-Pittsburgh Trust Co. known as the "Millman group".

In 1931, 12 independents closed and 5 were merged.

In 1932, 4 independents closed.

In 1933, 3 independents closed and one was on a restricted basis.

Of the 20 independent banks that closed from 1929 to 1933 only two reopened: The Homewood Peoples reorganized as the Homewood Bank. The Diamond National and Monongahela National reorganized and opened as the Pitt National.

Banks outside of Pittsburgh

As of December 31, 1929, in 17 towns in the Pittsburgh area were located 19 banks controlled by the Mellbank Corporation and 30 banks controlled by other interests.

As of December 31, 1933 the Mellon banks were 19 in number while the 30 independent banks had decreased to 13. Various Mellon banks were reorganized, etc., but none closed. One bank at Indian Head was taken over by the Mellon bank at Connellsville.

**Capital & Surplus
Pittsburgh Banks.**

As of December 31, 1929 there were 72 banks in Pittsburgh, of which 8 were Mellon banks and 64 independents.

These 8 Mellon banks had a total capital and surplus of \$115,570,430.00 on December 31, 1929 as against a total Capital and Surplus for 64 independents of \$111,073,330.00. The Mellon percentage being 51%.

During the period December 31, 1929 to December 31, 1933 the total capital and surplus of the 8 Mellon banks increased from \$115,570,430.00 to \$150,890,000.00 (an increase of 31%).

During the same period the 64 other banks in Pittsburgh decreased in number to 33 and the total Capital and Surplus decreased from \$111,073,330.00 for 64 banks to \$69,074,000.00 for 33 banks, a decrease in Capital and Surplus of 38% and a decrease in number of banks of 50%.

As of December 31, 1929 the 8 Mellon banks had 51% of the total Capital and surplus of all 72 banks in Pittsburgh and as of December 31, 1933 the 8 Mellon banks had 69% of the total Capital and Surplus of all 41 banks in Pittsburgh.

**Capital & Surplus
Banks Outside Pittsburgh.**

As of December 31, 1929 in 17 towns within 50 miles of Pittsburgh were 19 Mellon Banks and 30 independent banks.

As of December 31, 1929 the 19 Mellon banks had total Capital and Surplus of \$18,007,000.00 as against \$17,204,000.00 for 30 independents or 48% of the total of all 49 banks.

As of December 31, 1933 there were still 19 Mellon banks but the original 30 independents had decreased to 13. The 19 Mellon banks then had total Capital and surplus of \$12,063,000.00 as against \$5,483,000.00 for 13 independents or 69% of the total of all the 33 banks.

Capital and Surplus of Mellon banks decreased over this period by 35% and the 30 independent banks decreased 57% to 13 and Capital and Surplus decreased 68%.

Deposits
Pittsburgh Banks

As of December 31, 1929 the 8 Mellon banks in Pittsburgh had total deposits of \$437,895,880.00 as against \$540,182,770.00 in 64 other banks or 45% of total deposits in 72 banks in Pittsburgh.

As of December 31, 1933 the 8 Mellon banks had total deposits of \$505,445,000.00 as against \$298,785,000.00 in 33 other banks or 63% of total deposits in 41 Pittsburgh banks.

Over the period 1929 to 1933 deposits in 8 Mellon banks in Pittsburgh increased 13%. The 64 other banks decreased in number to 33 or 50% and total deposits in these banks decreased 45%.

Deposits
Outside Pittsburgh

As of December 31, 1929 the 19 Mellon banks in 17 towns outside Pittsburgh had total deposits of \$89,103,000.00 as against \$88,912,000.00 in 30 other banks or 50% of the total deposits.

As of December 31, 1933 the 19 Mellon banks had total deposits of \$70,229,000.00 as against \$21,451,000.00 in 13 other banks.

Over the period 1929 to 1933 the deposits in 19 Mellon banks decreased 21%. The 30 other banks decreased in number to 13 or 57% and deposits decreased 76%.

Loans and Discounts
Pittsburgh banks.


As of December 31, 1929 the 8 Mellon banks in Pittsburgh had 43% of total loans of 72 Pittsburgh banks as against 45% of total deposits.

As of December 31, 1933 the 8 Mellon banks had 56% of total loans in 41 Pittsburgh banks as against 63% of total deposits.

Loans in 8 Mellon banks decreased 41% from 1929 to 1933 and 64% in all other banks.

In 1933, of the 33 independent banks in Pittsburgh, 20 corresponded or cleared through the Mellon or affiliated banks as did 6 of the 13 independent banks outside the city of Pittsburgh.
