Carpenter advises ---

He talked to Chairman McCabe about the distribution of the Bank Holding Company bill -- McCabe asked him to tell you that it has been distributed only to the Secretary of the Treasury, Comptroller and FDIC, and he would suggest that the reply to DuBois state "the matter is in discussion stage with those three agencies and the Board is not prepared at this time to send a draft to the groups which discussed the bill with the Board Chairman."
