Just received following wire from World Peace Foundation New York QUOTE Following recent statements Secretaries Morgenthau and Hull and by Leon Fraser World Peace Foundation today initiating inquiry among banking executives as to need for stabilization STOP Our interest is in facts not propaganda but will release results of inquiry to public STOP Will you please extend your personal cooperation by wiring your own opinions as to effect stabilization would have on International relations and on welfare of American business including World trade and reduction of employment STOP Please state whether we may quote you or merely summarize your opinion among others STOP Growing evidence of relationship between American Prosperity World trade and peace and all major international questions including stabilization prompts this inquiry to you and one hundred and three other banking executives suggested in a conference this morning as probably willing to help us get the desired facts STOP Please address Raymond T Rich, Director eight West Fortieth Street UNQUOTE If you think it worth while am entirely agreeable to doing as have done in other cases if you will do the needful suggest you address your reply to F E Omero one Powell Street, SanFrancisco, Warmest regards.
