I am enclosing herewith a second memorandum, marked B, also prepared by Mr. Randolph E. Paul, listing a number of situations in which the tax laws might possibly be amended in the interest of taxpayers. I would like to have from you an estimate of the loss in revenue, if any, which would result from the adoption of Mr. Paul's suggestions.
