Subject: Treasury Meeting on Postwar

Tax Program.

Last week Mr. Blough called your office to ask you to send a representative to a tax meeting at the Treasury. The request was passed on to Governor Ransom. I was out of town and Mr. Hagen attended in my place. His report on the meeting is attached.

I have since talked to Mr. Blough over the phone. The meeting was called by Mr. Beil and was also attended by Mr. Blough, Mr. Colm from the Budget Bureau, Mr. Fritchard from Judge Vinson's office, Mr. Cohen from Justice Byrnes' office and Mr. Hagen from the Federal Reserve. The purpose was to organize this small group, which will meet throughout the summer to develop a Treasury program for postwar tax adjustments to be presented to Congress at a later date. Mr. Doughton has requested Mr. Beil to undertake such work in cooperation with Mr. Stan's staff. The first meeting of the group is scheduled for Monday, the 26th. I shall keep you advised on further developments.
