Dear Mr. Davis:

Secretary Wallace made an appointment for me to meet with him and Dr. Alexander at noon today, and I took with me Mr. Abner H. Ferguson, the general counsel of the Federal Housing Administration. Mr. Ferguson and I are to have a further talk tomorrow with Dr. Alexander and Mr. Mastin G. White, the solicitor of the Department of Agriculture.

Mr. Milo Perkins, who has been out of the city for a couple of weeks, is to return on Thursday. He and I will then look into matters of operating policy with a view to cooperative action on the part of the Department of Agriculture and the FHA.

I have an engagement for tomorrow afternoon at the Farm Credit Administration with Mr. R. W. Rigsby, the executive officer, and Mr. Peyton R. Evans, the general counsel.

I appreciate very much your friendly interest and assistance in this matter, and I look forward to an opportunity to discuss it further with you after these preliminary conversations with the agencies particularly interested in the farm provisions of our new legislation.
