The attached communication was sent to me from the Chairman's office without specific instructions. I do not feel that it is appropriate for me to send the Chairman comments on this matter.

You will recall that some months ago a difference of opinion between Mr. Piser and me arose as to whether tax estimates made here should be furnished to the Joint Committee and that you decided that the estimates should not be furnished. That decision destroyed a channel of communication through which it had formerly been possible to obtain information regarding decisions on legislation made within the Committee.
