Dear Mr. Harter:

Mr. Eccles has asked me to acknowledge your letter of January 23 in which you comment on his radio address. It is noted that you are opposed to the policy of expanding the Federal debt which I suppose means that you oppose its expansion at the present time as well as at any other time. Mr. Eccles is in favor of expanding the Federal debt when private debt is contracting and of reducing the Federal debt when private debts are expanding at a sufficient rate to insure relatively full employment in spite of the contraction of the Federal debt.
