Went to public schools in Englewood; also went to and graduated from Phillips Exeter School in New Jersey. From 1919 to 1929 was connected with the United States Mortgage and Trust Company of New York City as Treasurer, with salary of [REDACTED] per annum. Resigned from this institution to go with the firm of Bennett and Palmer, brokers, 165 Broadway, New York City. Was there from October, 1929, to January, 1932, and received salary ranging from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] per annum during that period. Came with the R. F. C. on February 22, 1932, as an examiner at [REDACTED] per annum. Received numerous salary adjustments and continued progress in the examining division until February 6, 1936, when he was made Assistant Chief of the Industrial Loan Division of the R. F. C. at [REDACTED] per annum. On February 16, 1937, he was transferred to the Detroit Loan Agency of the R. F. C. as Manager and his salary was adjusted to [REDACTED]. On April 11, 1938, he was made Manager of the Philadelphia Loan Agency and his salary adjusted to [REDACTED]. Stayed there until 3:00 p. m. on May 12, 1939, at which time he resigned.
