Dr. Harold D. Lasswell has recently completed a study, World Politics Faces Economics, for the CED Research Committee. In this monograph Dr. Lasswell analyzes the impact of economics on political policies with particular reference to the future relations of the United States and Russia.

Dr. Lasswell's report is particularly timely. He sees the United States and Russia emerging as the world's two major powers — the "bi-polar" powers — into whose orbits other nations will be drawn in their efforts to achieve security.
