Under date of December 4, 1943, Mr. Goldenweiser sent to each member of the Board a copy of a recommendation relating to System policy with respect to publications, speeches, and participation in outside activities by members of the System's research personnel, which had been prepared by a committee composed of Mr. Goldenweiser and the heads of the research departments of six of the Federal Reserve Banks. Copies of the recommendation were also transmitted to the Presidents' Conference.

Mr. Evans has asked that the recommendation be brought to your attention again at this time, as he would like to have the matter placed on the docket for consideration at the meeting of the Board on Friday, January 28, at which time he will recommend that the committee's recommendation be approved.
