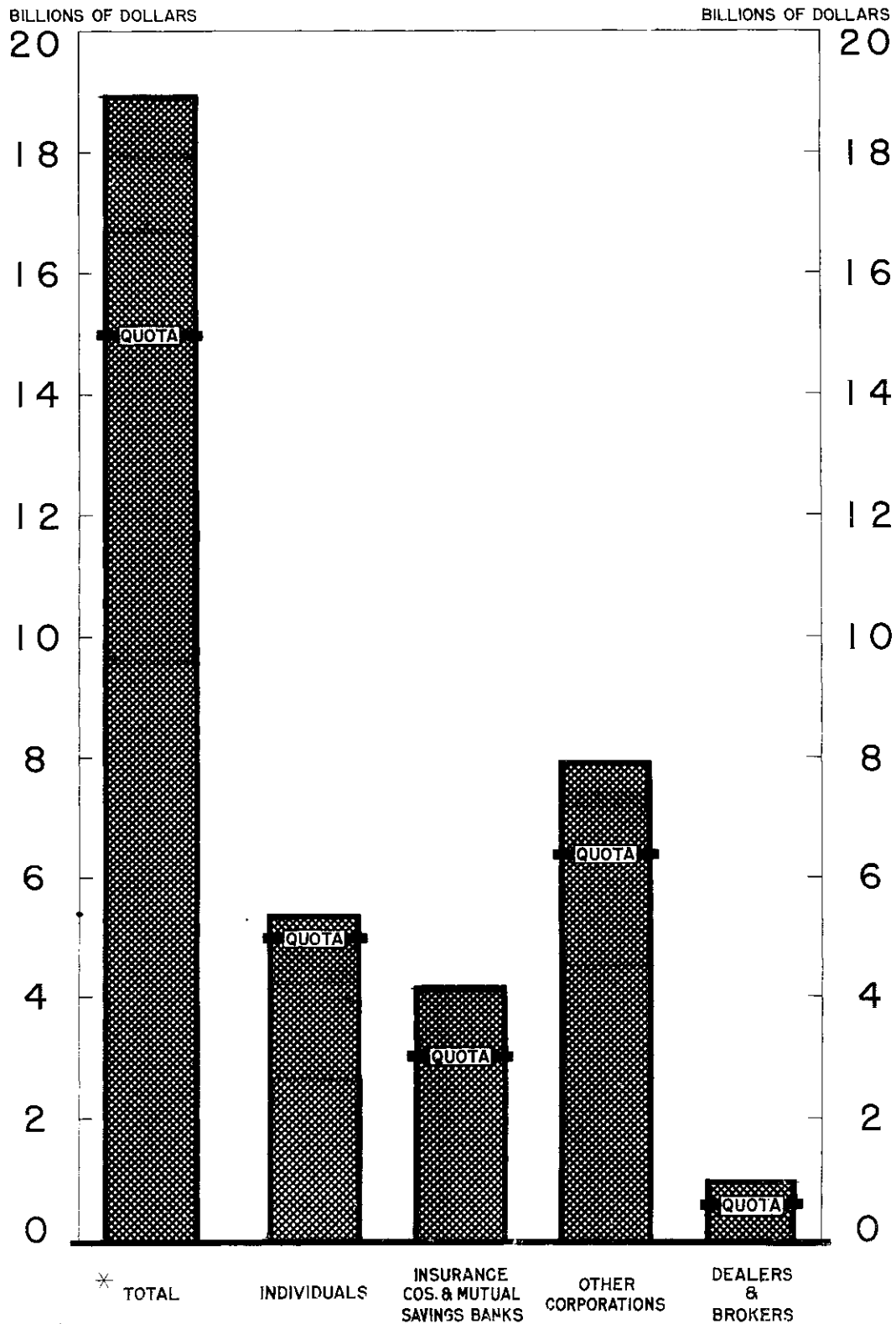

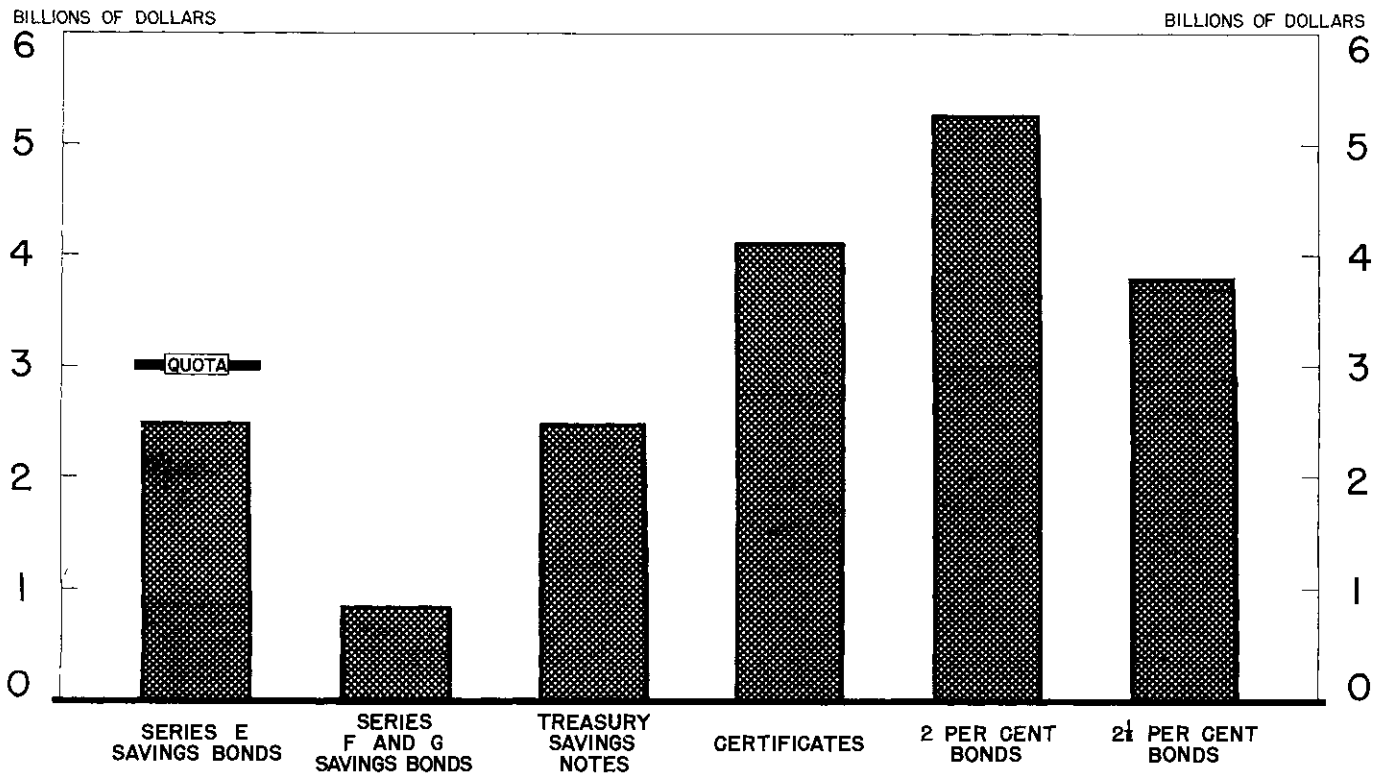
THIRD WAR LOAN DRIVE
