PERSONAL AND CONFIDENTIAL

My dear Wright:

This is to acknowledge your personal and confidential note to me of March 2. Following the hearing, when you suggested that a special report might be made in connection with problems of debt management as it affects the banking system, I reported to the Board and to members of the Federal Open Market Committee the substance of the questions and what I had stated to the Committee. As I sought to indicate then, the subject is an important one and requires very careful thought before attempting to formalize conclusions, so that while I hope to be able to send a special report to the Congress very promptly along the lines that were discussed when I was before the Committee, it will necessarily take some time to prepare it. I assume, of course, that any such special report to the Congress would be referred to the Banking and Currency Committee. It had not been my idea to attempt to draft a bill at this stage.

Needless to add, I appreciate your interest in and respect your understanding of these problems.
