My dear Mr. Eccles:

Many thanks for your kind favor of December 21st. I appreciate very much the stenographic transcription of your address before the American Bankers Association Convention in New Orleans in November. It is an able and straight forward statement of the facts and certainly should be redounded greatly to the advantage of the Administration.

I hope the recent adverse decisions of the Supreme Court will not have a detrimental effect on Mr. Roosevelt's re-election. So far as we are concerned in this state the new registration shows two Democrats to one Republican and I trust that this is the way we will find the ballots when counted in November. We certainly, however, should not be too optimistic but individually do all that we can between now and that time. Our family has always been Republican but I do not know of any member who is not going to vote for Mr. Roosevelt.

It is with pleasure that I note your nomination to succeed yourself as Chairman of the Federal Reserve Board and am looking forward to your early confirmation which will reflect much credit on the work you have done and also to the country in their wise selection.
