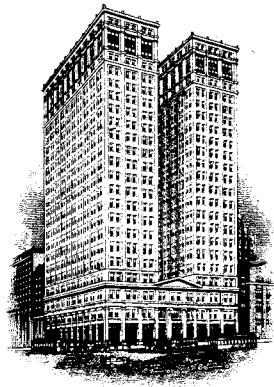


Dear Governor Eccles:
