Dear Marriner:

Wish to thank you for forwarding to me the copy of the address you made before the annual meeting of the Harvard Business School in Boston under date of June 16, 1939.

I have read the address and appreciate the sound argument which you have advanced in connection with economic conditions that are facing the Government and business.

We in the West only get a brief outline of what I term a very masterful address.

I have said to you before, that I think it is fortunate we have in public life men of your type and ability who are not dependent upon any political patronage or position. In this position you are able to outline very definitely, sound principles regardless of the political aspect of such utterances.

Occasionally we hear over the radio some of the outlines of our troubles advocated by you and others, but it is so seldom that we get the full address that I would appreciate, personally, your forwarding to me, if convenient, some of the addresses that you make in connection with problems facing business and the Government.

If you come West this year, I would appreciate your letting me know where you will be and I will undertake to have a visit with you and discuss the problems facing the lumber industry and business in general.

Last week while in Portland I contacted Mrs. Norman Stoddard and find that her husband is in a very serious condition with a bad case of heart trouble. He is now in the hospital and it is questionable whether he will ever be able to resume active work.
