A DISQUISITION

TO THE PRESIDENT OF EACH OF OUR 48 INDEPENDENT REPUBLICS

My dear Governor:

Think of it! "This Republic has no place for a vast military service and conscription...Inconsistent with republican institutions and condemned by the Supreme Court...We are not willing to surrender our civilization nor to convert the Republic into an empire." From the DEMOCRATIC platform of 1900.

Dr. Nicholas Murray Butler wrote in his book: "Why Should We Change Our Form of Government" (1913) that: "The representative REPUBLIC erected on the American continent under the Constitution of the United States is a more advanced, a more just and wiser form of government than the socialistic and direct democracy which is now proposed to substitute for it...To put the matter bluntly, there is under way in the United States at the present time (1913) a definite and determined movement to change our representative REPUBLIC into a socialistic democracy..It presents itself in many persuasive and seductive forms. It uses attractive formulas to which men like to give adhesion; but if it is successful, it will bring to an end the form of government that was founded when our Constitution was made and that we and our fathers and our grandfathers have known and gloried in."

When Dr. Butler became the head of the de-nationalist Carnegie "fronts" didn't he also become head of the above British Fabian "democracy" movement? Wasn't Teachers College, Columbia University founded to destroy our government via our schools under the guise of democracy? Isn't Sir Nicholas a modern Benedict Arnold not yet unmasked?

Turning to OFFICIAL definitions we find: Democracy is the "direct" rule of the people and has been repeatedly tried without success...Results in agitation, discontent and mobocracy...Attitude toward property is Communistic...The government of the United States is not a democracy but a republic.

The statement of former Governor Stassen: "That we are, and propose to remain a democracy" and his "cure all" declarations shows him to be ignorant of the form of government under which we live and that governmentally this socialistic crackpot doesn't know his elbow from a hole in the ground.

Senator Arthur H. Vandenberg stated in the "FOREWARD" of his book: If Hamilton Were Alive Today: "This country is frequently spoken of as a democracy and yet the men who established our government emphatically and repeatedly said that they had founded a republic...The most serious of all modern dangers to the Constitution, and therefore to the American people, are traceable to the neglect of these distinctions. Later this ambitious long-winded demagog and New Deal bedfellow wrote "democracy" articles and became one of the most infamous spouters of democracy in the Senate- doubtless at a price. The conclusion is immediate. What chance have we at any time if we tolerate men of the caliber of Stassen and Vandenberg to represent us? Moreover how can we take sides with one clique of nations against another clique in peace or in war - and be faithful to the pledge of allegiance at the same time? In the light of Art. 1 Sec. 8 Cls. 18 and Art. 2 Sec. 4 and Art IV Sec. 4 of our Constitution, do you think public officials and officers in the Army or Navy should be sufficiently educated and intelligent to keep their damn trap shut on matters pertaining to Congress exclusively - no matter what their position may be? There is something rotten somewhere. There must not be, there shall not be a Reichstag in America.

We Americans are opposed to democracy and to world organizations that involve the United States. We are dedicated to Constitutional "republicanism" and to "one Nation, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all" - ourselves first. Self preservation is the first law of nature.

What this country needs at the present time, more than any other one thing is men who understand the meaning of the Declaration of Independence, the "let everybody mind their own business" MONROE DOCTRINE, the CONSTITUTION and of sufficient character to honor an oath. Flag and Constitution have travelled side by side. They will stay up or go down together.

Why haven't Senator Vandenberg and his ilk been expelled from the Congress ere this? Why haven't the "Gunpowder" plotters - the men named by Col. Jennings C. Wise in Chap. VI of Woodrow Wilson (1938) been apprehended under U. S. laws on Conspiracy and on Sedition as you and all lawmakers, our public officials, our officers in the Army and Navy are twice bound and then paid at the expense of the taxpayers to do.? \*

Men who have a regard for the future of this country and the welfare of their children would do well to examine carefully one or more of the following: Journal of the Constitutional Convention - Madison. The FEDERALIST - Madison, Hamilton and Jay. Political Science and Constitutional Law - John W. Burgess. Constitutional Law of the U.S.A. - Dr. H. Von Holst. Back To The Republic (1918). Safe-Guarding American Ideals (1925) - Harry F. Atwood. The American Constitution - J. F. Stimson. Principles of Constitutional Law - Thomas W. Cooley. Constitution of the U.S. (1922) - James M. Beck, L.L.D. You should then know the nature of your rights and how to protect them. And also that the Constitution knows the Wagner Act, Bill "1776", the Conscription Act, the War Powers Acts and their trimmings - legislative boards and Commission - (O.P.A., W.L.B., W.P.B., etc.) are un-Constitutional, - if the Congress doesn't. Foreswear "2nd" and "revised" editions since 1932 and don't be fooled by the inaccurate and misleading definitions of "democracy" in the mis-called "Supreme Authority" and elsewhere. It is my considered judgement that a very great proportion of our national legislators are honest, well-meaning men whose most dangerous and deplorable crime is they have never studied the Constitution and know nothing of its meaning.
