We are forwarding to you today endorsement stamp to be used on items sent us for credit. It is important that you use this stamp so that we may register the items by use of the numerical system of the American Bankers' Association.

Upon the official announcement by the Secretary of the Treasury of the establishment of a Federal Reserve Bank in this district, and after you have made the required deposit of reserve money, you may begin sending us for immediate credit in your reserve account checks drawn by member banks on the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago and on the following member banks in the Central Reserve and Reserve Cities of this district:
