We enclose herein specimen form of draft which we recommend to be used in drawing drafts on this bank, in order that all drafts on us drawn by member banks be uniform in size and style. This draft is $8-1/2 \times 3-3/8$ inches, and can be cut without waste from 17×28 stock safety paper.

The name of your bank, followed by your number, according to the Numerical System of the American Bankers Association, should be lithographed or printed in the blank space at the top, right-hand corner of the draft, the name of your town and state on the date line. The style of type for the name of your bank is left for your own selection.

If you have not been informed of the number assigned to your bank, according to the Numerical System of the American Bankers Association, you will find the number on the envelope in which this Bulletin is mailed.

We shall appreciate your co-operation in the matter of securing uniformity of size and style of drafts drawn on this bank, and request that you advise your stationers and lithographers to conform to the standard herein indicated.
