To Lithographers, Engravers and Stationers:-

As we are receiving many inquiries with reference to a standard form of draft for use in drawing on this bank, we enclose a specimen which we are recommending to the member banks of District No. Seven.

This draft is 8-1/2 x 3-3/8 inches and can be cut without waste from 17 x 28 stock Safety paper.

The name of the member bank followed by its number in the American Bankers Association numerical system should be lithographed in one line in the blank space at the top of the draft, the town and state appearing on the date line. The style of type for the bank name is left to the discretion of the member bank.

We shall appreciate your co-operation in the effort to standardize the drafts used by our members in their dealings with us.
