TO THE BANK OR TRUST COMPANY ADDRESSED:

We regret that it has so far been impossible to secure for banks and trust companies the franking privilege in connection with notices to Liberty Loan subscribers. We are, however, prepared to supply, without charge, printed notices and envelopes for mailing. The usual postage must be affixed.

We send you herewith specimens of the following forms:

Request to care for past due payment.
- 2 - Form 431-D
Notice that bonds are ready for delivery.
- 3 - Form 431-E
Notice to subscribers of installment payments.
- 4 - Form 431-C D
Envelope for mailing

Be careful to stamp the name and address of your bank in the blank space provided on each notice; also list the A.B.A. number of your bank in the upper left-hand corner of the envelope under the return card in order that we may be able to return, without opening, any envelopes which fail of delivery.

Please advise us promptly how many of each form you will need. Order by Form Number. Do not over-estimate your needs. Additional supplies can be furnished as required.
