CONVERSION OF VICTORY NOTES

We are advised by the Treasury Department at Washington that-pursuant to reservation contained in Treasury Department Circular No. 138 no conversion of the 34% and 44% notes of the Victory Liberty Loan will be permitted until after July 15, 1919. This ruling is made in order to facilitate deliveries upon original issue.

The Treasury Department expects in the near future to issue Department Circular No. 139, prescribing the rules and regulations governing the exercise of the conversion privilege.
