DISPATCH OF REGISTERED MAIL.

TO THE MEMBER BANK ADDRESSED:

The Postmaster of Dallas has advised that under a recent ruling of the Postmaster General at Washington, all registered mail will be dispatched on daylight trains in the future, whenever possible.

Under this arrangement, it will undoubtedly take longer for registered mail to reach its destination than heretofore. In order that no serious inconvenience may be experienced, it is suggested that member banks place their currency orders with us sufficiently in advance of the date the money will be needed, to insure its receipt at the proper time.

The new arrangement should also be borne in mind in dispatching registered mail to this bank.
