REPORTS COVERING AFFILIATES

To the Member Bank Addressed:

You are advised that the Comptroller of the Currency and the Federal Reserve Board have further extended, until September 16, 1933, the time within which national and State member banks may file with the Comptroller, and Federal reserve banks, respectively, reports of their affiliates called for on July 7, 1933, pursuant to the Banking Act of 1933, and that such reports need not be published until they have been filed.

As stated in my circular letter of July 11, 1933, the reports covering the condition of your affiliates (if any) must show their condition as of June 30, 1933.
