CONDITION OF MEMBER BANKS, DECEMBER 30, 1933

To the Member Bank Addressed:

Condition reports have been received from all member banks as of December 30, 1933, in the Eleventh Federal Reserve District except one (whose report is still outstanding), and a number of banks operating under conservatorship which were not required to render a condition report on call date. These omissions should be taken into consideration in connection with comparative figures for former call dates.

Borrowings from all sources as of December 30, 1933, were \$1,062,000, of which \$573,000 represented borrowings from the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas.
