CONDITION OF MEMBER BANKS, MARCH 29, 1939

To the Member Bank Addressed:

Condition reports of all member banks of the Eleventh Federal Reserve District as of March 29, 1939, show total deposits of \$1,392,260,000, reflecting a decline of \$15,401,000 since December 31, 1938 and a net gain of \$68,400,000 since March 7, 1938. Loans, including overdrafts, as compared with March 7, 1938 show a net increase of \$34,832,000, while total loans and investments show a net increase of \$40,595,000 for the same period.

As compared with March 7, 1938 call, individual demand deposits and individual time deposits registered gains of \$32,078,000 and \$12,151,000, respectively. Borrowings as of March 29, 1939 aggregated \$423,000, of which \$372,000 represented borrowings from the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas. As compared with the December 31, 1938 call, borrowings from all sources show a net increase of \$399,000.
