Please refer to our circular letter dated April 26, 1940, advising that certain Federal Reserve banks and branches would observe daylight saving time from April 29 to September 28, inclusive.

We are now advised that beginning Monday, May 6, and ending Saturday, September 28, the Birmingham Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta will operate under daylight saving time. Accordingly, our time limit for the acceptance of wire transfers to the Birmingham Branch, for completion on date of receipt, will be one hour earlier than the time shown on the schedule, which is part of our Bulletin No. 6, dated September 15, 1939.
