The Secretary of the Treasury has issued the following revocation of General License No. 6 (Code of Federal Regulations, Title 31, Money and Finance, Treasury Chapter 1, Monetary Offices, Part 136):

REVOCATION OF GENERAL LICENSE NO. 6 UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 8389 of April 10, 1940, as amended, and Regulations issued pursuant thereto, relating to transactions in foreign exchange, etc.*

“General License No. 6 authorizing all payments, transfers and withdrawals from accounts of the Government of the Netherlands is hereby revoked.
