The Secretary of the Treasury has issued the following revocation of General License No. 7, as amended (Code of Federal Regulations, Title 31, Money and Finance, Treasury Chapter 1, Monetary Offices, Part 137):

REVOCATION OF GENERAL LICENSE NO. 7 UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 8389 of April 10, 1940, as amended, and Regulations issued pursuant thereto, relating to transactions in foreign exchange, etc.*

“General License No. 7, authorizing all payments, transfers, and withdrawals from accounts of the Government of Belgium and the Banque Nationale de Belgique, is hereby revoked.
