The results of this election are as follows:

Frank Turner, President of the First National Bank of Decatur, Texas, was elected by member banks in Group 3 as a Class A director of this bank.

J. M. West, Chairman of the Board of the West Production Company of Houston, Texas, was reelected by the member banks in Group 1 as a Class B director of this bank.

Each was chosen for a term of three years beginning January 1, 1941.
