The Secretary of the Treasury has issued the following amendment to General License No. 61:

“AMENDMENT TO GENERAL LICENSE NO. 61 UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 8389 of April 10, 1940, as amended, and Regulations issued pursuant thereto, relating to transactions in foreign exchange, etc.*

General License No. 61 is hereby amended by substituting in paragraph (1) (c) thereof the term ‘The Farmers Bank of China’ for the term ‘The Farmers Bank’.
