To the Member Bank Addressed:

We are advised by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System that all Federal Reserve banks and branches will be closed on Thursday, November 25, Thanksgiving Day, and also that all of the Reserve banks and branches will be closed on Thursday, November 11, Armistice Day, with the exception of the following:

The Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia will be open for such business as may be legally transacted but will not participate in the Interdistrict Settlement Fund clearing on November 2.

We are further advised that on November 11 and November 25 there will be no transit clearing through the Board's Interdistrict Settlement Fund.
