In addition, the Board has advised that Tuesday, November 2, Election Day, will be observed as a holiday by the following Federal Reserve banks and branches:

The Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia will be open for such business as may be legally transacted but will not participate in the Interdistrict Settlement Fund clearing on November 2.

We are further advised that on November 11 and November 25 there will be no transit clearing through the Board's Interdistrict Settlement Fund.

This information is being transmitted to your bank for its guidance in connection with transit operations and transfers of funds.
