COMMEMORATIONAL DATA ON SAVINGS BONDS

To Qualified Issuing Agents of
War Savings Bonds, Series E:

The State War Finance Committees generally are making plans for stimulating sales of savings bonds during the period immediately following the surrender of Germany. In connection with this program, the State or local War Finance Committees may prescribe forms of commemorative notations to be placed on the margin of bonds issued during that period.

The Treasury Department has stated that it approves of the use of such commemorative notations as may be prescribed by the State or local War Finance Committees. The notation may be affixed by the issuing agent in any manner **except by sticker or other attachment**. It is important that the notation be placed on the margin of the bond so that it will not interfere with the textual matter, the inscription, or the issue date of the bond. The issuing agent's dating stamp should indicate the date on which the bond is actually issued.
