The Love Field State Bank, Dallas, Texas, a newly organized, par, nonmember bank located in the territory served by this office, has notified us that it will open for business on December 15, 1945. We are informed that checks drawn on the new institution are collectible through the Dallas Clearing House, and accordingly, cash items received for collection by the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas will be handled on an immediate credit basis under the terms of our current bulletin on Transit Operations.
