**To the Member and Nonmember Clearing Banks  
of the Eleventh Federal Reserve District:**

We are advised by the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis that, effective May 25, 1946, the Little Rock banks, including the Little Rock Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis, will close at 12:00 noon, instead of 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays.

We also have advice from the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston that the laws of Massachusetts provide that Saturday may be a bank holiday during the months of June, July, August, and September. Accordingly, the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston will be closed on Saturdays during the period mentioned, and wire transfers to or through the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston cannot be completed on those days. Attention is also called to the fact that there may be a delay in the presentation of items and in the advice of dishonor and return of unpaid cash items as a result of those Saturday closings.

The Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia has advised us that banks in the State of Delaware, except those in Sussex County, are permitted to close on every Saturday during the year, but that only the banks in the Wilmington area have so far indicated that they will remain closed on all Saturdays.
