**To the Member and Nonmember Clearing Banks
in the Eleventh Federal Reserve District:**

The Federal Reserve Bank of Boston has informed this bank that the Governor of Connecticut on May 24, 1946, by proclamation, declared that each Saturday during June, July, August and September, 1946, shall be a bank holiday to be observed throughout the State of Connecticut, and that on such Saturdays all banking transactions in that State shall be suspended.

In view of the fact that the Connecticut banks will remain closed on Saturdays during the period stated above, there may be a delay in the return of dishonored cash items and in advice to you of nonpayment of such items.

Due consideration should also be given to the Saturday closing referred to, with respect to transfers of funds to and from banks in the State of Connecticut.
