## **1951 YEAR DATES FOR VALIDATING STAMPS**

Past experience prompts us to bring to your attention the importance of changing the year date in your dating stamp from 1950 to 1951, at the turn of the year.

Extreme care should also be taken in inscribing the issue date on United States Savings Bonds issued on or after January 1, 1951.

Your precaution in these respects will avoid to a great extent the necessity of recalling large numbers of bonds for reissue due to incorrect dating.

Paying Agents should make certain that the year date is changed in all payment stamps at the beginning of the new year.

1951 year dates will be sent to you on request.

*In the event your validating or payment stamp is worn to such an extent that a clear imprint cannot be obtained, we shall be pleased to furnish new stamps upon request.*
