**To the Member and Nonmember Clearing Banks  
of the Eleventh Federal Reserve District:**

Please refer to the time schedule effective January 15, 1957, which is part of our Bulletin No. 6 of the same date. On this schedule, it is stated that if any Federal Reserve bank or branch should adopt Daylight Saving Time, the time shown on the schedule would automatically be advanced one hour for the period of time the Daylight Saving Plan is observed by such Federal Reserve bank or branch.

For your information, the Federal Reserve banks and branches in the cities shown below will observe Daylight Saving Time as indicated:

Boston	From April 27 to October 26

During those periods, our time limit for the acceptance of wire transfers to such Federal Reserve banks and branches, for completion on date of receipt, will be one hour earlier than the time shown on our schedule.
