NOMINATIONS FOR CLASS A DIRECTOR SPECIAL ELECTION

To the Member Banks in the
Eleventh Federal Reserve District:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act and my circular dated July 21, 1964, in regard to the special election of a Class A Director of this Bank to succeed Mr. Roy Riddel, deceased, and to serve during the unexpired portion of his term of office ending December 31, 1966, there are listed in this circular the name of the candidate nominated for such directorship and the names of the banks which nominated him.

There is sent herewith to each bank in Group 1 a ballot for use in voting for a Class A Director. An envelope bearing on its face the certificate in regard to the vote and a colored envelope marked "Ballot—Directors' Election," in which the ballot is to be sealed, are also enclosed.

The ballot and certificate on the envelope must be executed by an officer who has been authorized to cast the vote. A list of the designated officers, revised to date, forms a part of this circular. In order that the balloting may be secret, the name of the bank and of the voting officer should not be written on the ballot but only on the certificate envelope. If the official signature of the officer casting the ballot has not been filed with this Federal Reserve Bank, such official signature should be filed before the polls close.

Please follow carefully the instructions which are printed on the ballot and on the envelopes.

The following procedure is required:

- (1) The ballot should be marked.
- (2) It should then be placed in the colored envelope marked "Ballot Directors' Election" and the envelope sealed.
- (3) Then after the certificate on the certificate envelope is executed, the colored sealed envelope should be placed within the certificate envelope and that envelope sealed.
- (4) The sealed certificate envelope containing the sealed ballot envelope should then be returned to me in the enclosed self-addressed envelope.

Under the law, the ballot must be returned so as to reach me within 15 days after its receipt. The polls will open on August 31, 1964, and close at 2 p.m. on September 15, 1964. At that time the ballot box will be opened at this Bank, the sealed envelopes containing the ballots will be opened, the votes counted, and the results of the election announced. The candidate is invited to be present or represented on that occasion.

While the banks in Groups 2 and 3 will not vote in this election, this circular is sent to them, without forms, for their information. Group 2 consists of member banks with combined capital and surplus of \$400,000 and over, but under \$2,000,000, and Group 3 consists of member banks with combined capital and surplus of under \$400,000.

MURRAY KYGER

Mr. Kyger was born in Mason, Texas, on November 24, 1905. He attended Mason High School, was graduated from The University of Texas with a B.B.A. degree, and received his L.L.B. degree from the South Texas School of Law. He has also done graduate work at the Stonier Graduate School of Banking at Rutgers University. While at The University of Texas, he was elected to Beta Gamma Sigma, a business fraternity, and to Sigma lota Epsilon, an honorary management fraternity.

He began his business career in 1928 with the Houston Land and Trust Company, Houston, Texas, where he served successively as Assistant Trust Officer, Trust Officer, and Vice President and Trust Officer. He was also a director of that firm.

In 1941 Mr. Kyger joined The First National Bank of Fort Worth as a vice president, and he has served that organization continuously since that time. He was elected to the board of directors of that bank in January 1947, Executive Vice President in January 1955, President on July 1, 1958, and Chairman of the Board on December 17, 1963. Mr. Kyger has been the chief executive officer of The First National Bank of Fort Worth since July 1961.

Mr. Kyger is active in many banking and civic organizations. He is presently a member of the Economic Policy Committee and the National Bank Division of the American Bankers Association, a trustee of Texas Christian University, and a director of the Graduate Research Center of the Southwest. He is a past member of the

board of directors of the Association of Reserve City Bankers.

He is married and has two children and resides at 110 Rivercrest Drive, North, in Fort Worth.
