To comply with this approach, please make the following changes on the formats of Schedule C and Worksheet #2 for Schedule C:

- 1. Under the caption "Real Estate Loans" on Schedule C, Line 44, Loans Purchased and Serviced should read Loans Purchased, Not Serviced.
- 2. Line 44 on the detail Worksheet #2 for Schedule C also should be changed to read Loans Purchased, Not Serviced.
