I am pleased to announce that the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has appointed Dr. Chas. F. Jones, President of Humble Oil & Refining Company, Houston, Texas, as a director of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, effective October 22, 1968, to fill the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 1968, and for a three-year term beginning January 1, 1969. Dr. Jones succeeds Dr. Kenneth S. Pitzer, President and Professor of Chemistry, Rice University, Houston, Texas, who resigned effective September 30, 1968, since he is moving to California to accept the presidency of Stanford University on December 1, 1968.
